POLICY 5055: DISTRICT PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

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POLICY STATEMENT

The Board encourages and supports the development of a District Advisory Council (DPAC) as per the constitution prepared by the District Parents' Advisory Council.

LEGISLATION/REGULATIONS

- *School Act, Section 8, 8(4), 8(5), 67(5.1)*
- *Coast Mountain School District Policy 5050, Parent Advisory Councils (PAC)*

PROCEDURES

1. There must be only one District Parent Advisory Council (DPAC) in the school district.
2. Each school Parent Advisory Council (PAC) may elect annually one of its members to be its representative on the District Parent Advisory Council (DPAC) for a term of not more than one year.
3. DPAC may advise the Board on any matter relating to education in the school district.
4. DPAC must make bylaws governing its meetings and the business and conduct of its affairs, including bylaws governing the dissolution of the council.
5. The Superintendent of Schools, his/her designate, or a school trustee may attend any DPAC meeting.
